	Send the positive employee home Contact the local health department with the following information: - The last day the employee worked - A list of people who may have been in close contact with the employee while at work Normal Business Hours: 618- 498- 9565 After Hours: 618- 463- 2921 Clean and disinfect the workplace that the employee had contact

	For employees who have symptoms, use the symptom- based strategy. Exclude from work until at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared and at least 3 days have passed since recovery For employees with no symptoms, use the time- based strategy. Exclude from work until 10			
	days have passed since the date of their first positive COVID-19 test, as long as they don't develop symptoms If they are a close contact with someone with COVID-19, they will be quarantined at home by the local health department for 14 days from the date of last exposure.
